

Holy Days of Obligation

On holy days of obligation, Catholics are *obliged* to participate in Mass. Every Sunday is a holy day of obligation, as are six other days throughout the year. In the United States, these holy days of obligation are

- **January 1:** The Feast of Mary, the Mother of God
- **40 days after Easter Sunday:** Ascension Thursday
- **August 15:** Assumption of Mary into heaven
- **November 1:** All Saints' Day
- **December 8:** The Feast of the Immaculate Conception
- **December 25:** Christmas, the Nativity of Our Lord
